The CSA Meeting for November will be held on Tuesday, November 7, 7:15 pm at Wesleyan University, Middletown. (directions on page 2).

CSA is pleased to present our special guest, Dick Gabriel, Dick Gabriel, is Assistant to the President - Special Projects, American Federation of Musicians, and was recruited by the AFM after a successful music career performing both as an artist and backup musician. He has performed with such legends as Chuck Berry, Elvis Presley, The Buddy Miles Blues band, and The Beach Boys. He was member of the 60s/70s music group, "Gary Puckett and the Union Gap." At the AFM, he eventually became the head of the AFM's Electronic Media Division, negotiating contracts and providing services to musicians working in commercials, television, motion pictures and phonograph recordings. Among other things, he developed the AFM's system which monitors and collectson behalf of musicians when their recording is used for any purpose other than that for which it was originally produced. This system brings millions of additional dollars to musicians each year. His current focus is to make musicians more aware of the importance of treating their music career as a business, pointing out the numerous and often overlooked services and sources of revenue that are available to both signed and unsigned artists.

He currently negotiates special agreements for unique productions in Sound Recording and Television, makes appearances at conferences, seminars and schools presenting panels and as a speaker on the various aspects of the business of music and better ways to approach it.

CSA CRITIQUE SESSIONS: At regular monthly meetings, following the presentation, as time permits, there will be a song critique session. To participate, bring a song on cassette or CD, or do it live, with 20 copies of typed lyric sheets, and receive constructive feedback. Critique sessions are a good forum for works in progress or rough demos. best feedback, note on your lyric sheets the intended genre and audience for your song, and what your goals are (i.e. picked up by a commercial artist, self-produce, etc.. Do NOT state what the song is "about"). For non-members, \$5 of your registration fee is applicable toward membership if you join within 30 days. Members are encouraged to bring a friend who might be interested in what CSA offers. .

DIRECTIONS TO MEETING LOCATIONS

How to Get There!

Directions to Wesleyan University:

The meeting room at Wesleyan is B2B, South College near the Chapel in the core of the campus.

- -- From New Haven take I 91 north to Exit 18 which is Route 66 which becomes Washington St in Middletown. Go right onto High St. after Memorial Green. The chapel and South College are on High St. See Wesleyan Univ. sign at the corner of Washington and High St.
- --From the Merritt / Wilbur Cross Parkway (Route 15) to Route 66 east to Middletown.
- --From Hartford or from New London, take Route 9 to Exit 15 in Middletown. This is Route 66 which becomes Washington St. High St is a left just before the Green.
- --From Waterbury, take I 691 past Meriden. 691 becomes Route 66. See above.
- --For automated travel directions call 860-685-3390.

Directions to Mystic Union Baptist Church for Mystic River Folk: Coming North on I-95, take Exit 89. Go right off the Exit onto Allyn St. Go about 2 miles and come to a light and the intersection of Rt 1. Turn left onto Rt 1 and go a short way to the 5-way intersection. Church is on the left. Make a hairpin left to get to the parking lot.

GUIDELINES:

- At least one writer must be a current CSA member
- Songs for the Holiday collection must be appropriate for the December Holiday Season (Christmas, Chanukah, Thanksgiving, New Year, etc), and for the Spiritual/Inspirational collection, songs must fit the theme. please specify for which CD you are submitting.
- Any musical style is okay
- Submission is NOT a guarantee of acceptance. Songs will be selected based on :
 - -- Appropriateness to the theme
 - -- Song Crafting
 - -- Production Quality (must be professionally recorded and radio-ready)
 - -- Available space on the CD (if there are more acceptable submissions than can fit on the CD, those submitted earlier and those of shorter length will be given greater consideration.
- Songs must not violate the terms of any third-party agreement (e.g. with a publisher). Unsigned songs are preferred. If a song is under contract to a publisher, a signed release from the publisher must be provided.
- Songs may not have been included on any previous CSA Compilation
- Submissions will not be returned.

TO SUBMIT, PLEASE SEND THE FOLLOWING:

- A recording of the song on CD, suitable for duplication (put your name and contact info on the CD)
- A lyric sheet (put your name and contact info on the lyric sheet)
- A signed release form, printed out from the CSA web site (www.ctsongs.com)
- A non-refundable one-time \$10 processing fee payable to CSA (there are no additional costs, whether a song is accepted for inclusion or not)

Send your recording, lyric sheet, release form, and \$10 to CSA, PO Box 511, Mystic CT 06355.

IF YOU HAVE A SONG which is not yet fully produced and you want to know if it acceptable for consideration before doing the production, you may bring it to a CSA critique session, OR send the rough recording to CSA, PO Box 511, Mystic CT 06355. Include your e-mail address.

Since 1989, CSA has produced 14 compilation CD's of member's songs. Now, in partnership with IndieGate digital distribution, CSA compilations released since 2005 are being made available online for DIGITAL DOWNLOAD, and the CSA writers will receive the standard royalty (currently 10 cents for writer plus publisher share.) for each download.

This is a great opportunity to get your songs in front of a worldwide audience and to help CSA and yourself as well.

So far, "CSA Sampler Volume 10", and "Share the Journey" are all available through this new IndieGate partnership. IndieGate will be the exclusive distributor for CSA compilation digital downloads. This way, if for any reason you decided to not have your song in distribution, it can be removed.

A link to the Indiegate store is now available from the CSA website.

Keep in mind that the quality of a digitally downloaded song is typically slightly less than that of the song on a physical CD. Of course you can still purchase complete regular CD's from CSA. We are simply adding a new option for individual digital downloads.

These are not free giveaway downloads -- they are paid digital downloads, with royalties going to the writers.



SONG CRITIQUES Members may bring a song or lyric on cassette to the monthly meeting for critiquing by fellow members. Please bring 30 copies of typed lyric sheet. Out-of-State members may have their songs or lyrics critiqued by sending one submission with 30 typed copies of lyrics to: CSA, PO Box 511, Mystic CT 06355. Include a stamped return envelope. Comments by the group will be summarized in writing and sent back to the writer.

Please note that since critiquing is designed to give constructive feedback and suggestions for improvement, songs which are meant only to be shared for self expression (as opposed to critiqued for improvement) should not be submitted. These can be presented in song-sharing opportunities.
